Maximal volume of the paper is 7 print pages, including References and Figures

The following chapters should be included in the manuscript:

1. Title
2. Author(s)
3. Author(s)' affiliations
4. Abstract (max 250 words)
5. Key words (max 7)
6. Introduction
7. Materials and methods
8. Results and discussion
9. References (max 20)
10. Figure legends
11. Figures (each figure as a separate file; TIFF format; size 13x18 cm, dpi 600; color figures are free of charge in the PDF-version)
